The organization DISTRICT DISABLED SCHOOL(DDS) originated as a grass roots level organization that catered to the micro aspects of the area focusing on community its organization, promoting social cohesion and catering to basic needs of the disables-Marjory, visually impaired, hearing impaired, mentally challenged & Cerebral Palsy children of socio-economically poor families who are in un-reached areas. In fact, DDS started as an Activist Organization during the year 1998 which tried to visualize the problems of locality and needs of people at micro level & raise voice for people.

The dedicated & committed spirit of Mr. Bibekananda Mishra is the Founder of Dist. Disabled School (DDS) had prominent impact upon his contemporary people who joined him to start this social venture with an indomitable spirit of rendering service to the social excluded children.

The genesis of DDS reflects more a process – of proven eventual development characterized by change in attitude and mode of action towards rights, entitlements as well as duties and responsibilities among the downtrodden deprived mass than a mere showdown of activities undertaken for the cause of those neglected mass for development.

### ➤ Organization

The District Disabled School (DDS) Jharsuguda is a non-profit making voluntary organization of the Jharsuguda district. It was established in the years of 1998 and it has been stated from 7<sup>th</sup> June 1998 at Sarbahal, Jharsuguda. This organisation initially started in the Sarbahal, word no 1 of Jharsuguda district and it was shifted on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2001 to Buromal (Budapara) Po: Sarbahal, Jharsuguda Odisha for permanent settlement. On the occasion of World Autism Awareness Day, a special awareness event was organized at the District Divyang School campus in Budapada, Buromal, Jharsuguda. The program was conducted jointly by the District Administration and the District Divyang School. During the event,



Dr. Prakash Chandra Rana, serving as the keynote speaker, explained the causes, symptoms, and interventions for autism, emphasizing that *"children with autism tend to live in their own world."* Sunil Kumar Naik, the District Social Security Officer, attended as the chief guest. Founder and psychologist Vivekananda Mishra also

addressed the gathering, stating that children with autism often live in isolation, away from their families, and eventually create a world of their own. He highlighted that autism is typically detectable within the first 19 months of a child's life, and due to their social challenges, these children often face difficulties in interacting with others. Other dignitaries who spoke at the event included Pranati Patnaik (DDRS Administrator), Pandit Nikunj Bihari Jyotish (Secretary), and Bijay Saigal (Joint Secretary), who shared their insights and messages regarding autism and the importance of inclusion. On the occasion of World Health Day, an awareness camp was organized by Vedanta Jharsuguda at the Jhadeswari Independent Divyang School located in Budapada Buromal. This



school caters to visually impaired, hearing and speech-impaired, and mentally challenged children.

During the event, Dr. Jay Narayan Pujari and Dr. Subrat Kumar Pujari from Vedanta's Mobile Medicare Unit, along with pharmacist Sanjeev Sahu, addressed the students with disabilities, as well as the school's teachers and staff. They provided guidance on how to

maintain good health, stay disease-free, and lead a healthy life. They also shared what should and should not be done in daily routines to achieve this. Dr. Pujari emphasized the impact of mental health, stating, "Negative thoughts are a major cause of mental illness." The session was presided over by the school's founder, Mr. Vivekananda Mishra. During the program, Upendra Bhainsa, the head trainer of the hearing-impaired department, translated the speech into sign language for the hearing-impaired students. The admission ceremony at Jhadeswari Independent School for the Differently-Abled was

On the first day of the 2024–25 academic session, 16 differently-abled children were enrolled during the first phase of admission. Some children, who did not yet

possess their disability certificates, have been placed on a waiting list by the selection committee. A resolution was passed allowing their admission during the second phase once they obtain the required certificates. Additionally, the school has decided that new applications from differently-abled children will continue to be accepted until all available seats are filled. To mark the occasion, the school premises were decorated with colourful rangoli, and a traditional kalash (auspicious pot) was placed at the entrance. The newly admitted children were welcomed warmly with sandalwood paste and flowers by the teachers.

Around 60 parents participated in the meeting and engaged in discussions. During the event, emphasis was placed on how to take care of children with disabilities during the summer holidays. It was also explained that, under the instructions of the National Trust, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment,



Government of India, all children with intellectual disabilities, cerebral palsy, autism, and multiple disabilities will be included under the Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme. The benefits and procedures for availing this scheme were also discussed.
